Working with the Director of Technology (DOT) and Community Manager (CM), you will focus on the member experience, helping them connect to the office network, printer, and various audio/visual equipment.

- Working with a small, nimble technical team responsible for 312 Main's technology systems and IT operations
- Work with members to access the network and printing resources
- Assist members with Audio/Visual equipment and troubleshooting
- Understanding the network infrastructure to better diagnose and report issues
- Monitor and report on network performance and usage
- Assist with access control (key fob) and network security systems
- Able to work overtime/weekends occasionally, sometimes on short notice in emergencies
